Keep fresh, clean water before calves at all times.

When calves are of age, feed an excellent quality legume hay.

Feed a quality, palatable calf starter ration

House calves in warm, dry and draft-free quarters.

Follow the program of your feed serviceman after calves are weaned.

To maintain freshness, keep unused portion of milk replacer in a closed bag or sealed container and store in a cool dry location.
